About G6: G6 is a happy, bubbly and active little girl who loves puzzles, books, drawing, writing, being active, singing and dancing!

G6 has a diagnosis of Global Development Delay, and her cognitive development is similar to a typically developing 3-year-old at present. She is generally very capable but will need some support and encouragement to reach her personal milestones. She is an absolute joy to be around and thrives when receiving 1-1 adult interaction/attention. G6 is verbal however her speech is delayed, and she will often use singular words or learnt phrases to express her needs. She currently attends Speech and Language therapy once per week.

G6 is very active and loves to get involved in new activities! if engaging in a less physical activity, then this should be planned to take place for no longer than 1 hour as after this, she can understandably become a bit restless and disengaged. We are looking for a Sennie who can match her energy and enjoy creating activities that will best suit her.

G6 has no behaviour challenges at present. If she doesn't want to do something, she will ignore you or say no. If G6 feels significantly dysregulated, she will go quiet, become subdued, keep herself to herself and on the very rare occasion get irritable.

G6's key areas for development and support are:

- Speech and language development

- School drop off & pick up (change out of school clothes before snack time)

- Creating visual aids (timetables, meal plans etc.)
- Cooking dinner and feeding G6
- Homework help and support
- Planning appropriate activities and outings
- Taking G6 to/from activities, clubs, appointments and playdates
- Support potty/toilet training
- Organising daily educational activities that are also fun for G6 to take part in after school
- Upkeep of children's/areas
- Tidying up areas after use such as the kitchen or bathroom
- Implementing strategies and/or therapies
- Help G6 build upon her independence
- Personal care duties (bathing, feeding, changing, toileting etc.)
