Ideally, the family are looking for term time support in the morning and after school from Tuesday - Friday and 8 hours on a Saturday, with full time cover during the holidays. About G16: G16 is a happy and sociable young lady, who has athetoid/dystonic Cerebral Palsy, affecting all four limbs, and significant communication difficulties. Despite her lack of verbal communication, she is a very bright and intelligent teen, who is progressing well at school. She has a great sense of humour, always strives to achieve as much as she can, despite her disabilities, and is great company!

G16 requires personal care assistance with all aspects of daily living and is dependent upon a wheelchair for all functional mobility. She receives weekly specialist Physiotherapy input and follows a programme of Physiotherapy at home. She currently wears a back brace for 23hrs per day pending an operation to correct a spinal scoliosis. It is key we find a reliable Sennie who can support the family on a long term basis to ensure they have trusted support in place prior to and following G16's operation. Whilst prior experience is an advantage, personality and work ethic are more important as training is provided for all aspects of the role and the selected Sennie will also be supported by a trained care team following G16's operation.

G16 has developed some behaviours that challenge including temper tantrums. These stem from her frustration at her lack of control over her life. It is suspected that she has some Autistic traits, although diagnosis is difficult given her other disabilities. Autism experience would be an advantage.

About the role/responsibilities: The family are looking for someone cheerful and energetic, who can build a real friendship with their daughter, whilst helping her with her daily routine. G16 communicates well using an eye gaze communication system, which also enables her to access her school curriculum, homework, email and the internet. The selected Sennie will accompany G16 to local leisure activities as well as attending to her personal care needs (dressing, bathing, feeding and taking her to the toilet) and take an active role in her medical and therapy needs. Training will be provided by the parents/therapists, which will include but is not limited to, learning her physiotherapy programme, manual handling techniques and development of independence skills. This is a fantastic opportunity to join a wonderful family and expand on your SEN/PMLD childcare knowledge and excel in your SEN career.

G16 really enjoys adapted sports and is a real thrill seeker! She regularly participated in swimming, sit skiing, sailing and bowling. Luckily they have a number of the facilities on site (swimming pool, sauna), so a Sennie who is up for these activities is key, so they can enjoy them with G16. As well as reading, watching Strictly Come Dancing and baking, she also loves getting out and about, going to the cinema, on shopping trips and socialising with her friends. You will have to be able to organise and accompany her in these activities, as well as being enthusiastic in initiating new hobbies and helping her to develop her social life. It is key that her new Sennie is able to create a safe, nurturing and stimulating environment in which she can thrive and develop.

As the role includes time off, in term time, during the day, it would be suited to someone who is studying at University (SEN related course), or who has an interest/hobby they wish to pursue whilst G16 attends school, someone from a Nursing background or wishes to pursue a career in nursing and/or care, SEN Nannies, SEN 1:1's looking for a career change.
