About the role/family: **SENNIES** is excited to support a returning client find a part-time Sennie as their current Sennie who has been there for 2 years is moving out of London!

There will be two locations as the children are at each parent's house every other week. But also this can be fluid in the week. The locations are Barnes and Chiswick. The parents are both friends and the arrangements are amicable.

About the child/children:

Boy (15 - SEN) is an active, verbal, happy, loving boy. He has moderate learning difficulty, dyspraxia and autistic tendencies as part of Coffin Lowry Syndrome. He is attending a specialist school. You'll need to be fit, strong and vigilant to ensure his safety, especially when outside. He has trouble with transitioning sometimes as well as attention and listening issues, but he has no challenging behaviour and is a very charming and funny boy. The family are looking for someone to be B(15)'s buddy / carer.

The family are working with B15 to build upon his independence, particularly around dressing and toileting and helping with tasks. They are looking for someone to help support this in the safest way possible. He wants to join in with everything his brother is doing but he has trouble with big physical games and needs support. He has some physical needs as he has Dyspraxia and can fall but he can walk. The family wants someone with clear boundaries and a flexible approach to ensure B15 does not hurt himself. He has no understanding of danger or strangers, meaning he will quite happily take anyone's hand! He is very chatty and loves to stop and have a chat with a dog and its owner.

He loves playing board games and can independently play if he is set up to succeed. He loves being read to. He really enjoys listening to music and playing his CD's so a music lover would be fabulous!

Boy (13) is charming, enjoys football, riding his bike, reading and computer games. He will need help with homework, extra-curricular activities, hobbies and having fun.

This family is looking for a proactive, bubbly and passionate SEN Nanny who can provide fantastic support for both boys. You will support B(13) during his after-school routine; assisting with personal care, having dinner, playing and/or going out for a walk and accessing activities. During the school holidays, you will organise fun activities and outings for both boys.

Main Duties:

- Potential Pick Up for B15
- Following the daily routine set by the family
- Facilitating and arranging play dates
- Taking the children to any appointments that are deemed to be routine for example Physio or If the boys need to go to the doctors/dentist for a non-critical appointment
- Researching and Arranging holiday activities
- SEN input for B15 to be agreed in advance. Examples: Toileting, Independent skills, Educational Tasks
- Supporting B15 at after-school clubs
- Preparing light meals for the boys
- Supporting along with the family homework being completed on time
