B6 finds emotional regulation, activity transitions, and staying focused challenging. We hope the selected Sennie can work with B6 to support him in these areas, thus building upon his independence.

**B5** does not have additional needs, is very bright and enjoys being intellectually challenged (numbers, letters, etc.). He is very sensitive and enjoys lots of hugs. He is very witty and funny, and loves playing LEGO, cooking, and reading books.
