This role would also suit a teacher, SEN TA or 1:1, who has the school holidays off and is looking for extra work.

The boys usually have a Sennie each during the holidays, although some aspects of the job are working with both boys, including but not limited to meal prep, mealtime, and mornings before the second Sennie arrives. The selected Sennie will have the opportunity to double up with existing team members for as long as needed to ensure they feel confident in their new role & before taking either of the boys out alone. The family are very hands-on and can provide additional training and support for the right candidate.

This wonderful family has a great track record of Nannies/Sennies staying long term. They have created a happy, respectful work environment for all the team involved, making them fantastic employers. Their current Nannies/Sennies have been with them for 2 - 6 years, and they are looking for a team player who understands the importance of consistency and collaboration.

In terms of hours, they are looking for a Sennie to live-in (own bedroom and bathroom provided) each week (Monday to Friday) during the boy's summer school holidays. If you are based outside of London, you will be able to stay in the family home over the weekend; however, you must adhere to the house rules provided.

There is a level of flexibility in days worked, as you are working as part of a team. Shifts can be scheduled to suit the team before each school holiday begins. Commitment and reliability are a must. This could lead to further employment with the family on a long-term basis for the right person.

**About B13(Twin 1):** B13 is a lovely, energetic, fun-loving little boy who has a diagnosis of Autism, Moderate Learning Difficulties and Severe and Complex Speech, Language and communication needs.

*Interests:* Swimming, gymnastics, walking, theme parks, drawing, music

**About B13(Twin 2):** B13 is a 'hilarious, cheeky, crazy' (his words) little boy with a diagnosis of Autism & high Anxiety.

*Interests:* Disney, computer games, reading, swimming, movies

Both boys attend different SEN schools, and one of them is termly boarding during term time, so the extra support is needed for the summer holidays on a live-in basis.

Duties:

- Supporting the boys in their morning routine before the other Sennies arrive
- Supporting the boys with their evening routine once they are dropped off by their Sennie/s
- Preparing meals and feeding one/both boys in the morning and evening
- Preparing a packed lunch (when required) for the boys for their day trips
- Support on a day trip (when required or if you are available for more hours)
- Occasional (local) shopping/light duties
- Household duties:
  - Children's laundry
  - Tidying the children's bedrooms
  - Empty / load dishwasher
  - Tidy up at the end of the day
