About the role/family: **SENNIES** is excited to support a family of 5 find a flexible part-time Sennie to integrate themselves into a busy household. Mum is a classical musician who tours the world and works on a freelance basis, which means her schedule is different each month depending on her work. Dad is also a musician but with a slightly more predictable schedule. They have three wonderful children, and they are working towards turning down the emotional temperature and finding a higher level of regulation for everyone within their home. They have a number of strategies in place - including a trampoline in their kitchen - to encourage the sensory seekers to move, regulate and find calm. The property is located behind a security line which will require their new Sennie to undergo significant and advanced police checks. Please note this is out of the family's control and is non-negotiable.

About the child/children: **G12** is creative, kind, intelligent, independent, capable and a very trustworthy tween! She will need guidance more than care and is fantastic at lending a helping hand! She loves music, dance, creating art and her favourite thing, Reading! **G12** is neurotypical.

G10 is intelligent, highly capable and, more often than not, an absolute darling to be around! She loves to make movies on her iPad (live-action, which she edits); creative writing; loves to research information; adores animals and TV shows about animals. She's a great reader too! **G10** has a diagnosis of Autism (with a PDA and sensory profile) and ADHD. The VITAL piece of information about **G10**, she runs away when emotionally overloaded. Predicting these moments is near impossible, but knowing that jealousy, embarrassment, and justice are three big triggers can be of assistance. She has an EHCP at school and is currently attending neurodevelopmental therapy.

B7 is a sweet, deeply loving and caring little boy who loves to colour in, draw, cut out, paint, write, and play with trains and number blocks! **B7** has a diagnosis of Autism (with a PDA profile, particularly around transitions) & ADHD and at present struggles with emotional regulation and staying in his seat when attending school.

He adores his big sisters, and when they are sad, he will dash around to fetch their favourite items of theirs to bring them comfort. He is a WRIGGLER and finds it almost impossible to sit still. He goes to ballet and swimming lessons and loves to leap about. Books are a passion, and he can bring you books to read for hours.

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All children have a packed schedule of activities, many of which are conveniently located within walking distance from their family home. However, B7 and G10 will require transportation to and from school, which is why having a driver would be preferable. Additionally, the selected Sennie will need to actively engage with them to ensure that their homework is completed after school.

 - The family are very open to all candidates and will consider all options around employment to find the right match. The family can also offer training to a candidate who is dedicated to staying long-term

We are looking for a patient and calm Sennie who can identify triggers and reduce anxiety for everyone. They should be flexible, creative, and able to handle high-pressure situations. Physical fitness is important as the children may run off. Patience is key for managing meltdowns.
