The boys usually have a Sennie each during the holidays, although some aspects of the job are working with both boys, including but not limited to meal prep, mealtime, and mornings before the second Sennie arrives. The selected Sennie will have the opportunity to double up with existing team members for as long as needed to ensure they feel confident in their new role & before taking either of the boys out alone. The family are very hands-on and can provide additional training and support for the right candidate. For trips out, the family will often arrange 2:1 care.

This wonderful family has a great track record of Nannies/Sennies staying long-term. They have created a happy, respectful work environment for all the team involved, making them fantastic employers. Their current Nannies/Sennies have been with them for 2 - 6 years, and they are looking for a team player who understands the importance of consistency and collaboration.

 - Tidying the children's bedrooms
