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About the role/family: **SENNIES** is excited to support a loving and hard-working family in Battersea, South West London, find a Sennie to provide part-time or wrap-around care for their 4-year-old daughter. Mum and Dad both work from home and when restrictions allow they will attend the office 2 days per week. The family hope to find an experienced Sennie but also welcome the opportunity to support and train a less experienced Sennie following great experiences with hard workers and dedicated childcarers they've worked with, in the past. Personality, fit and commitment are key and the most important thing is that the Sennie can provide excellent care for G4 and, become part of the family.

About G4: G4 is a friendly, curious and determined little girl with enormous potential for development who loves reading books, going to the park, swimming and playing music! She was born with a Rare Chromosome Condition, currently non-verbal so requires dedicated 1-1 support throughout her day. G4 also has epilepsy and takes medication twice a day however seizures are infrequent (once every 4-6 months) so epilepsy experience is useful but not essential and training can be provided in regard to G4's specific plan. To support her development, G4 also attends Physiotherapy and Chiropractor sessions weekly. The selected Sennie will take G4 to her sessions and sit in where appropriate, so they can ensure a consistent approach is taking place and carry out any exercises correctly as advised by the therapist.

G4 attends a Specialist Nursery from 12 pm - 3 pm, 5 days per week, therefore the family needs morning and afternoon support (Wraparound care). The family are happy to consider candidates who can only commit to the morning or the afternoon so please share your availability when applying.

Mum and Dad currently support G4 by creating a loving home environment and supporting sensory development through play, whilst encouraging constant communication. They hope to find a Sennie who is experienced or willing to learn/research suggestions for sensory toys and other items which will support G4's growth and development.

G4 key areas for development and support are:

- Cognitive development
- Support with speech and language development
- Following her Physio programs as set out by therapists

Main Duties include:

- Nursery drop off and/or pick up
- Meal planning and cooking for G4
- Planning appropriate activities and outings before and after nursery and in the holidays
- Taking the G4 to/from activities, clubs, appointments
- G4's laundry and keeping her room tidy
- Nappy changing and support potty training
- Behavioural support and management
- Bring forward any key areas for development
- Tidying up areas after use such as the kitchen or bathroom
- Working alongside the school/other specialists
- Keeping G4's calendar organised/up to date including medication renewal
- Implementing strategies and/or therapies as requested by the family specialists
