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About the role/family: **SENNIES** is delighted to support loving, working parents to find a Summer holiday Sennie with the potential of becoming a permanent member of the team if things go well and the chosen Sennie would like to commit long term to support the family on a part or full time basis!

About B11: B11 is a sweet, loving and energetic young man who loves to be kept busy doing activities with meaning and purpose. He loves to learn, enjoys playing games with simple homemade items and enjoys arts and craft activities. He loves to be outdoors and going for outings in the car. If allowed to, however, he will stay on his iPad watching Youtube videos all day, so this is something to watch out for and be avoided.

B11 has a diagnosis of Autism and ADHD. He is verbal but his language is limited and the family prefer to stay away from PECS as a form of communication. B11 is good at listening to instructions and can easily express his wants and needs to others. He also enjoys using his language to tell others what to do and enjoys being the leader. His main challenges are focusing for long periods of time and emotional dysregulation. When he is calm, B11 is a sweet and kind young man but when he is emotionally dysregulated he can display behaviours that challenge and his triggers are not always obvious. The best approach is to step away, give him space and allow him to self regulate.

B11 attends a special school a short drive from his home and will soon be moving into a higher ability class. During the school holidays, the family would like their school holiday Sennie to support B11 with his reading, numeracy, language etc. at home and when out in the community. The selected Sennie will also be expected to help facilitate interactions with other children eg. in the park when on an outing, to support B11 with his social and emotional communication. B11 also needs support to learn socially appropriate behaviour such as not hanging around people he doesn't know and respecting the personal space of others.

B11 gets on best with confident and engaging people who know how to have fun and enjoy being silly from time to time!

B11's Key areas for development and support are:

- Keeping busy with learning activities and fun activities both inside and outside the home
- Focusing for a long period of time
- Social interaction with other children - He loves other children but is very socially immature and doesn't know how to initiate conversation or pay attention

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Planning appropriate activities and outings
- Planning summer holiday activities/timetable
- Taking B11 to/from activities, clubs, appointments
- Occasional overnight care required (proxy parenting)
- Behavioural support and management
- Organising educational activities
- Bring forward any key areas for development
- Cleaning up after children's mealtimes
- Keeping the house tidy and tidying up after yourself and B11 whilst on duty
- Working alongside the school/other specialists
- Implementing strategies and/or therapies as recommend by Specialists
- Engaging B11 in his preferred activities
- Tutoring for educational support
- Help B11 build upon his independence
