About the role/family: **SENNIES** is excited to help a welcoming and flexible family of 3 in Twickenham find a Sennie to care for their wonderful daughter who is four years old. They require support before and after school, including school drop-offs & pickups, and in the school holidays. G4's specialist school is 6 miles away which is a 20-40 minute drive (traffic dependent) from the family home, so we are looking for a confident driver with prior experience supporting a child with communication challenges.

The selected Sennie will be able to quickly build rapport with G4, thus becoming a positive part of her communication journey. The family are looking for someone who will be proactive in setting up and happy to support, playdates and other social activities for G4, as these are important for her social, emotional and early years development.

About G4: G4 is a happy, warm and sociable little girl who loves being outside, going to the park, arts and crafts, Peppa Pig, reading and all animals, especially dogs! Her favourite film at the moment is Encanto, and her favourite book is The Tiger who Came To Tea.

G4 has a Speech Delay (diagnosed as a Language Disorder) and is currently limited to singular words but is making great progress!

G4 attends a specialist school (currently only three days a week) as well as her mainstream nursery. In September she will be at her specialist school full-time, starting in Reception. Her specialist school sets a new topic every few weeks, which the new Sennie will be able to engage G4 in at home to support consistency. Her specialist school meets all of her therapeutic needs, so she doesn't attend any therapies outside of her time at school. However, she does require a Sennie who can carry out simple strategies for continuation in everyday activities. The family's main goal is to find someone who can connect with G4 (which is not difficult!) and understands how to communicate effectively with children with communication challenges (gesturing, Makaton, simple phrases, clear spoken words etc.)

- Speech, language and communication
- Proactively booking and supporting G4 on playdates
- Ensuring G4 spends lots of time outdoors (which she loves!)

- Taking the G4 to/from activities, clubs, appointments & playdates
- Engage G4 in after school activities daily
- Bring forward any key areas for development

- Cleaning up after G4's mealtimes
- Loading/unloading dishwasher
- Tidying up areas after use such as the kitchen or bathroom
- Purchasing necessary food or sundries
- Organising appointments for G4
- Engaging G4 in her preferred activities
- Bathtime and Bedtime routine
- Help G4 build upon her social and emotional communication
- Help G4 build upon her independence
- Personal care duties (bathing, feeding, changing, toileting etc.)
