#### Essential Skills/Traits:

- Fluent English speaker
- A minimum of 2 + years of SEN childcare experience. ( Ideally a physiotherapy or Speech and language therapy or support background)
- Prior experience supporting a child who is Non-verbal
- Clean UK driver's licence and a confident driver
- Epilepsy experience is advantageous but not essential as training will be provided and B13's seizures are controlled

**About the role/family:** **SENNIES** is excited to help a wonderful family in Maida Vale find a full-time sennie to join their team! They currently employ a Manny who has been with them for ten years and will, unfortunately, be moving on. Ideally, the selected candidate will be able to commit long-term, and be able to start on or shortly after 22nd August 2022.

The family are looking for a happy, calm, caring, reliable, proactive and committed Sennie to work with their adorable 13-year-old son who has special needs (global developmental delay, severe learning disabilities, non-verbal and some visual impairment). Experience with speech and language therapy and non-verbal children would be a big advantage. However, their current Manny came with little SEN experience and has been an asset to their family since day one due to his hard work and dedication to their son. The family can provide a Motability car, and the selected Sennie would be required to drive B13 to/from his school in Swiss Cottage, which is a 10-minute drive from their home.

**About the child/children:** **B13** is a very happy child who needs constant stimulation to encourage him to develop, build upon his independence, gain confidence, and explore his surroundings. He will also need support to avoid some self-stimulatory behaviours that can make it more challenging for him to focus or participate in activities. He enjoys outdoor activities such as horse-riding, skiing, and swimming. He enjoys watching his iPad, and the family are working towards developing his iPad skills as a means of communication.

B13 has a diagnosis of Global Developmental Delay, Autism (non-verbal), and Cerebral visual impairment. At present, his cognitive ability is similar to a typically developing 2-year-old. B13 attends a Specialist School where he receives excellent input from a Physiotherapist, Occupational Therapist, Speech and Language Therapist, and Music Therapist. We are looking for a Sennie who can continue daily support for B13's therapy programs to help B13 thrive at home and in the community!

#### B13's key areas for development and support are

- Speech and communication skills
- Life skills, including self-feeding, toileting, dressing and self-care.
