About the child/children:

B4 is an energetic, curious and active little boy who is always on the go! B4 is a sensory seeker, and he loves mouthing things, so it's important that the Sennie can keep an eye on what he is putting in his mouth at all times. B4 loves being outdoors and messy play, so the right candidate would need to be enthusiastic about searching for creepy crawlies in the garden and running around! B4 needs someone who can provide him lots of attention and care, as he forms bonds with people quickly.

B4 is pre-verbal, and uses some Makaton signs at home, so the ideal Sennie would have a prior knowledge of (or a willingness to learn) Makaton. It's important B4's Sennie understands the level of constant supervision he requires to ensure his safety, whilst ensuring his summer is filled with lots of exciting, engaging activities! When dysregulated, B4 may throw his toys, but the family is keen to support B4 in learning new ways to express himself. B4's younger brother, B1, attends a childminder during the day but the Sennie may occasionally be required to care for, and plan activities for both B4 and B1 at times.

Main duties / responsibilities:

- Ensuring B4's safety and wellbeing at all times, in particular, monitoring what he's putting in his mouth
- Organising engaging, fun activities which his younger brother, B1 could also join in with at times
- Providing simple, healthy meals and thickening B4's drinks appropriately
- Support with toilet training, and encouraging B4 to use the toilet regularly throughout the day
- Knowledge of (or willingness to learn) Makaton
- B4 is recovering from a broken leg, so at times may require lifting and carrying at times
- Encouraging B4 to wear his glasses
